## Foreign Patents

A U.S. Patent allows the patent owner to exclude others from making, using, selling, and importing an infringing product into the United States, but provides no rights outside the United States. There are two commonly used avenues to obtain rights in other countries.

- 1) If you filed a U.S. Patent before any public disclosure anywhere in the world, you may file foreign patents within one year of the US filing date, and the foreign patent applications will be treated as if they were filed when the US Patent Application was filed.
- 2) You may file a Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) application within one year of the U.S. filing date, and you obtain an additional 18 months to file foreign applications. Please note that Argentina and Taiwan are not part of the PCT.
